SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

WHAT IS THE SCHOLARSHIP?

A £1000 scholarship is available to students who have achieved outstanding results in their GCSEs or who have demonstrated an incredible talent or performance. This could be through a sporting or dramatic performance or through a demonstration of phenomenal resilience or determination.

SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED – TWENTY IN TOTAL

- Top GCSE Scholarship – Awarded to the top ten attaining students in GCSEs
- Creative Arts Scholarship – Awarded to a student who has an aptitude for the Arts – Art, Drama, Dance and/or Music
- Sports Scholarship – Awarded to a student with sporting prowess
- Academic Scholarship – Awarded to a student who has demonstrated outstanding academic achievement in one or more of the following;
 - Science
 - Maths
 - English
 - Humanities
 - Social Science – Sociology, Religion, Media and/or Business
 - Art, Design and Technology
 - Health and Fitness – PE, Health and Fitness, Health and Social Care
 - Modern Foreign Languages

WHO IS ENTITLED TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

- All incoming year 12 students, internal or external, can apply
- Twenty scholarships will be awarded

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- A £1000 scholarship will be awarded to students
 - £500 will be paid in December of Year 12 to help students with the transition from to Sixth Form
 - The final £500 will be paid in April of Year 13 to help students with preparations for exams, university or life after Blenheim Sixth Form
- Students are required to complete an application form
- Video evidence or a live performance/demonstration is required for an Art or Sport scholarship
- Teacher references are required
- Interviews take place after students receive their results
- Students will form part of the Blenheim High Performers Programme and receive subject specific or general mentoring and support for their academic development
