



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

WHAT IS THE SCHOLARSHIP?

A £1000 scholarship is available to students who have achieved outstanding results in their GCSE qualification or who demonstrate high levels of talent and performance in a particular field. This could be through curriculum areas such as Sport and the Creative Arts or through more personal characteristics such as work ethic, resilience, innovation or improvement.

SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED – TWENTY IN TOTAL

- Top GCSE Scholarship – Awarded to the top ten attaining GCSE students

An additional ten scholarships will be awarded to the students who put forward the most compelling case. This will be demonstrated by their application form and their performance in interview.

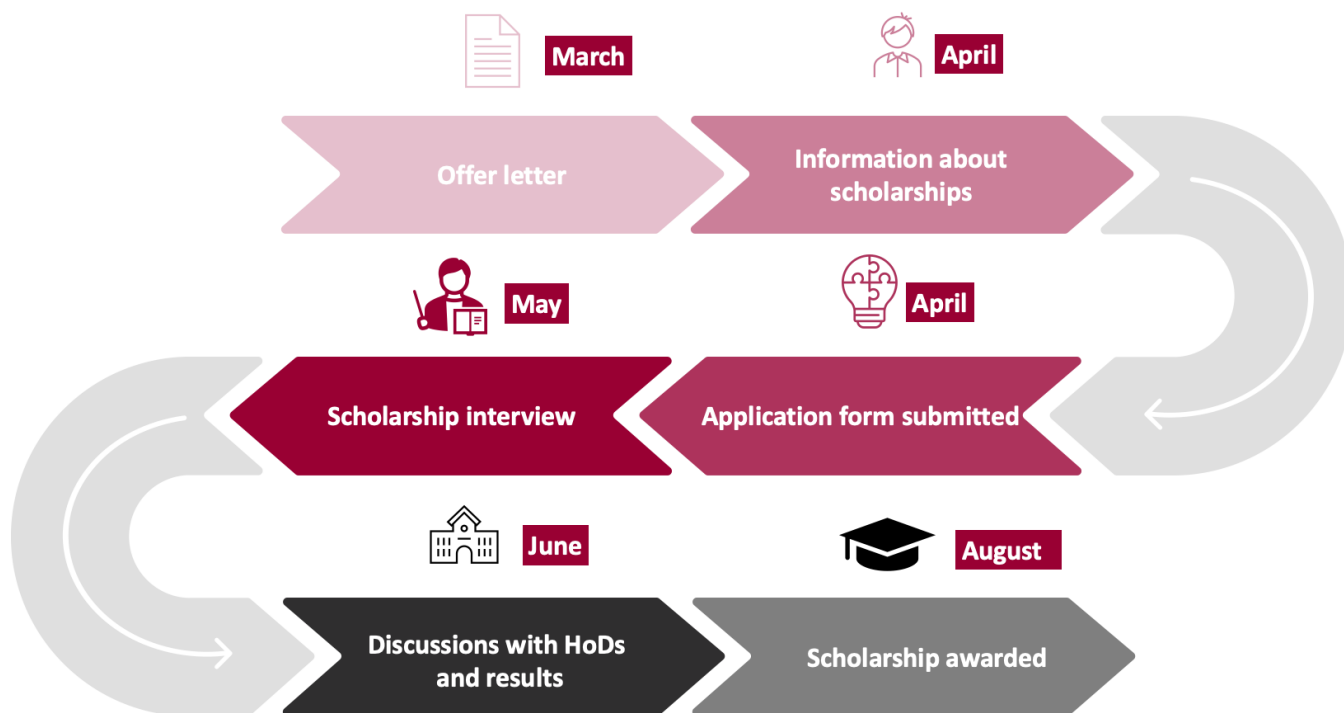
- Creative Arts Scholarship – Awarded to a student who has an aptitude for the Arts – Art, Drama, Dance and/or Music
- Sports Scholarship – Awarded to a student with sporting prowess
- Academic Scholarship – Awarded to a student who has demonstrated outstanding academic achievement in one or more of the following;
 - Science
 - Maths
 - English
 - Humanities
 - Social Science – Sociology, Media or Business
 - Art, Design and Technology
 - Health and Fitness – Physical Education, Health and Fitness, Health and Social Care
 - Modern Foreign Languages

WHO IS ENTITLED TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

- All incoming year 12 students in September 2022, internal or external, can apply
- Twenty scholarships will be awarded

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- A £1000 scholarship will be awarded to students
 - £500 will be paid in December of Year 12 to help students with the transition to Sixth Form
 - The final £500 will be paid in April of Year 13 to help students with preparations for examinations, university or life after Blenheim Sixth Form. The final payment is under the proviso that students make a positive contribution to Blenheim Sixth Form.
- Students are required to complete an application form
- Video evidence or a live performance/demonstration is required for an Art or Sport scholarship
- Teacher references are required
- Students will then be interviewed
- Students will form part of the Blenheim High Performers Programme and receive subject specific mentoring and support
